I would like to report to you the economy is getting better and the financial condition of the course is improving. Unfortunately, I cannot do that. Some news on the positive side is your City committee met last week with the City's new Administrator, H. Harold Duffey. The City in these difficult times is finding it hard to find funding for anything. Mr. Duffey said there may be funds available in the city's Air Port Fund. I have apprised Mr. Duffey, reminding him that Table Mountain Golf Course, in the past seventeen years has been the largest contributor to the Air Port Fund of nearly three quarters of a million dollars. As most of you know, Table Mountain Golf Course, Inc. is one of the few municipal golf courses that is not subsidized by the City that owns them. We are also approaching our deadline to renew our lease which we are still negotiating. Please be patient with your Board of Directors as we are working in the background to make Table Mountain Golf Course reasonable in its fee's and to have the City support us financially. This is a very important time in the history of Table Mountain Golf Course, Inc. and we need the support of our membership in our future negotiation with the City Of Oroville.

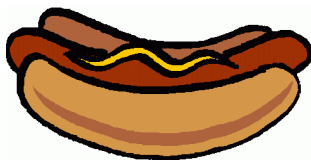
