In my last message to the members, we had agreed to terms on a new 30 year lease for the club with the City of Oroville, plus agreeing to a major remodel of our clubhouse. Unfortunately, progress has stalled over the holiday season. Although we met formally with the City Council to approve the terms of our new lease, we have not been able to sign the lease and remodel agreement.

This delay has pushed back our expected start date for the remodeling. Your Board of Directors is disappointed at the delay as we hoped to get most of the new remodel done while we were in the slow winter months. We will continue to push for a quick and favorable outcome in our negotiations with the City. However, we do have our plans and budgets in place for a busy 2010 golf year at Table Mountain Golf Course.

We have some exciting things planned for 2010. Patrick Waymire, our course superintendent, has a very long list of course improvements planned. Including new tee boxes on holes 5 and 9, a new water feature at our signature hole, #16, and a redo to the driving range with expanded netting, new aiming poles and tee areas. Todd Moran, our head pro, has been busy bringing in new merchandise for the 2010 season, and getting our tournament schedule and twilight leagues ready to go.
