ON THE COURSE, by Stacy Baker, TMGC Director of Agronomy

First, I would like to thank the membership and golfing public for their warm welcome back to Table Mountain Golf Club. It has been very nice to see some familiar faces and meet new members. The 12 years I spent away from TMGC saw me working at Peachtree Country Club and later at Haggin Oaks Golf Complex. I currently have the honor to service on an executive committee with the Golf Course Superintendent Association of America that recommends and approves all educational seminars and sessions at the Golf Industry Show. Twice a year, I attend the committee meeting at the national headquarters in Lawrence, Kansas paid for by the national association. In addition, I was one of 22 superintendents to be awarded a 3-day learning academy at the Wake Forest Business School last November in Winston-Salem, NC. Through the committee work and Wake Forest experience I have met some amazing people that have helped guide me in expanding my knowledge and networking.

The Course. The first few weeks I have spent assessing the course conditions, shop, tools, equipment and staff. Many changes are in progress. A majority of the equipment was not working or cutting. The irrigation has been adjusted and increased with many more improvements to come. The Proper Way to Repair a Ball Mark



- 1** Use a prolonged ball mark repair tool (preferably), knife, key or tee.
- 2** Insert at the edges of the mark- not the middle of the depression.
- 3** Bring the edges together with a gentle twisting motion, but don't lift the center. Try not to tear the grass.
- 4** Smooth the surface with a club or foot. You're done when it's a surface that you would putt over.
