PRESIDENTS MESSAGE

To our members at Table Mountain Golf Club, once again we are facing difficult times not only in the local area, but across the entire world with this current Pandemic. We are currently enforcing the SDR (social distancing requirements) at the club to ensure that you can continue to use the facility, but we needed to make some serious changes at the club to enable us to follow the required SDR.

All food and beverage items will be "to go ordering" no exceptions, we want to minimize the contact as much as possible to you and our employees. Please observe the signs we have posted at the club to ensure SDR measures are followed. Out on the course you'll see the various precautionary measures we have applied, again to avoid touching of items the general public would normally come in contact with during play. Avoid touching during the round, such as giving a high five or knuckles to your playing partners after a great shot or putt, it's for your own protection and theirs. Once the round is completed and you want to order an item from the bar or grill, call in your order from the #17 teeing area or #8 teeing area making the turn, so your "to go" items are prepared, minimizing your time at the register. After the round we have to avoid gathering, in and around the club house or at the driving range as much as possible, again following SDR protocol.

As a club we will attempt to continue to operate, ensuring that SDR are being followed as well as sanitizing the contact points during operating hours of the facility. There are other golf courses in the North state that are allowing play, on the premise "essential activity like the ability to engage in outdoor activity", provided all individuals comply with SDR. We will make all efforts to remain open for play, if this pandemic across the nation doesn't reach a level of calmness in the near future, we would be required to close the facility.

Patience is the utmost importance while you're visiting the club, enjoy your round of golf, respect your playing partners SDR and the staffs as well, we want to see everyone enjoy the golf course during these difficult times we are facing across the nation and the world.

Table Mountain Golf Club COVID-19 Precautions

The safety of the staff and patrons are TMGC's highest priority during this time. Below are some practices on how to reduce the spread of the COVID 19 virus, we appreciate your cooperation to help make our facility as safe as possible for all.

- If you feel ill, stay home.
- Observe "Social Distancing". We have put lines near door entrances to provide guidelines for that distancing. Please observe during your round as well.
- There are no ball washers accessible, no water coolers, no scorecards or pencils, and no rakes available on the course. Please use your club or foot to flatten out the sand.
- The cups will be set one inch above the ground level. If your ball hits the cup it is considered "holed". Please do not touch the flagpole.
- If you choose to ride in a cart it will be only one person per cart. The carts will be properly sanitized including the seat, steering wheel, key and sand bottle.
- Only allowing one person per cart, we may not have a cart available for everyone. Therefore be prepared to walk.
- No personal contact such as hand shaking, fist pumping, elbow touching, etc.
- Wash or sanitize your hands often. We will have sanitizers located around the facility as well as hand soap in the restroom's.
- The pro shop and restaurant will be open for one customer at a time.
- We suggest you call in your order for better service. 530-533-3922 ex. 2.
- Call the pro shop to book your tee time or visit our website.
- Please show up to your tee time at least 30 minutes early to avoid long lines and "Social Distancing" .
- Please refrain from browsing through merchandise. If you know what you want please have pro shop staff get product for you. Demo equipment is not available.

We want to provide an atmosphere that allows our customers to enjoy the park setting and the fresh air. Thank you in advance for your patience.
